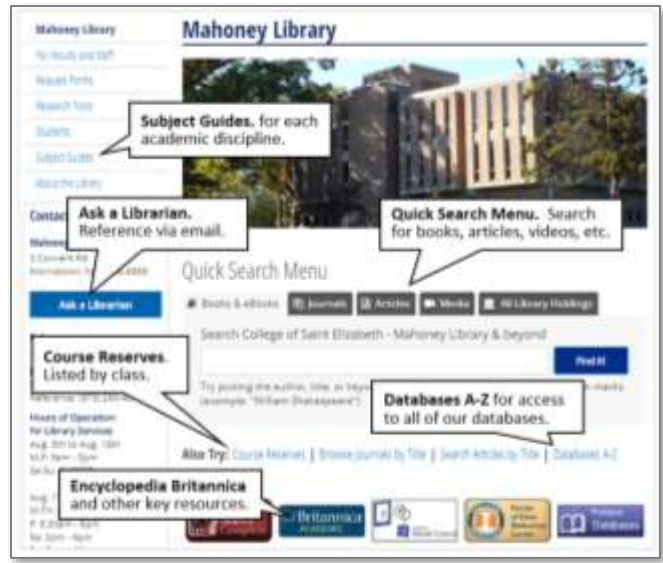


# Education: 2021 library research guide

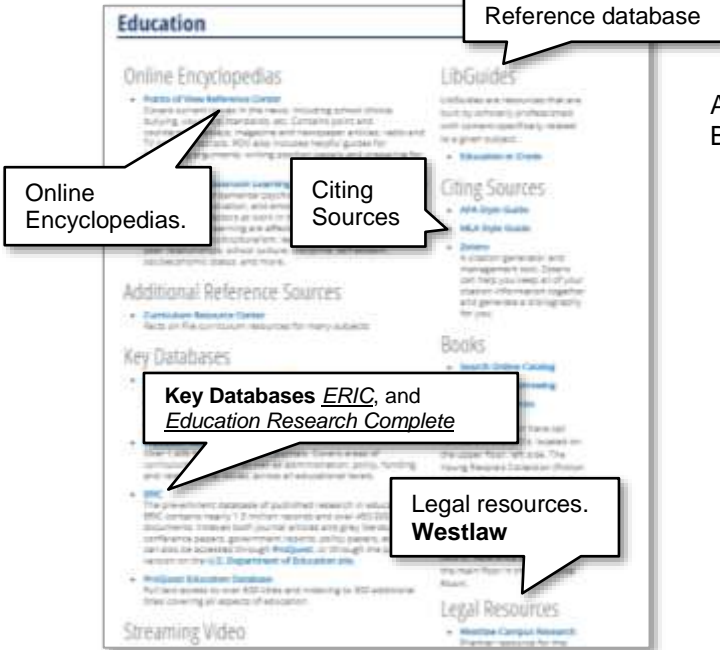
## I. The New library homepage.

- A. **Subject guides** for each academic discipline.
- B. **Quick Search menu:** for books, articles, videos etc.
- C. **Course reserves.** Books made available for your class by your instructor.
- D. **Databases A-Z.** Full listing of all the databases available through the library.
- E. **Ask a Librarian** Reference services via email.
- F. **Encyclopedia Britannica** and other key resources



## II. Education subject guide:

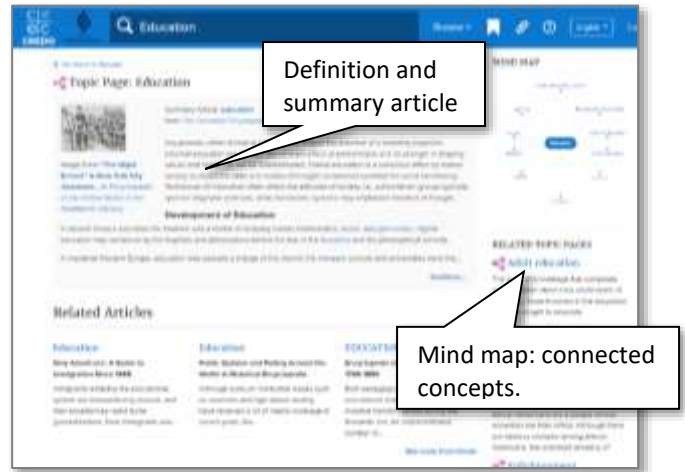
Crdo LibGuides Reference database



- A. Click the *Subject Guides* link on the library homepage.
- B. Select **Education** from the list of academic disciplines listed on the page.
  1. Top: Online Encyclopedias such as *Psychology in the Classroom*. See also **Crdo** for additional reference sources.

  3. Center Left: Key Databases: *Ed. Research Complete* & *ERIC*.

  5. Below: Legal Resources: **Westlaw**.

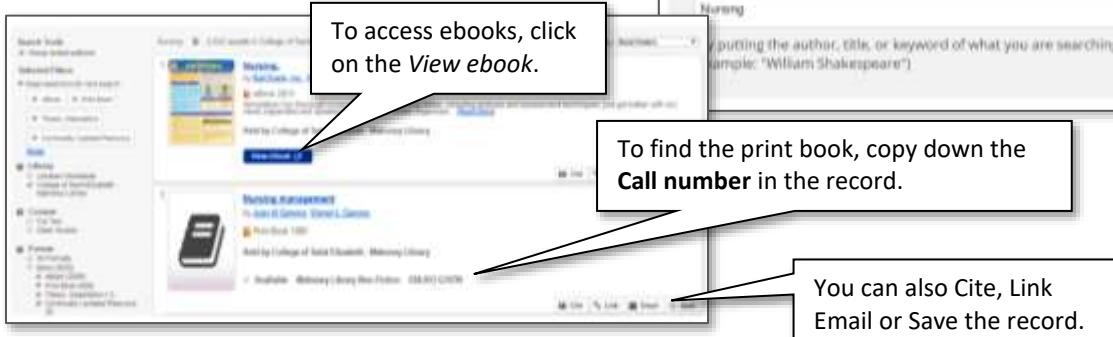
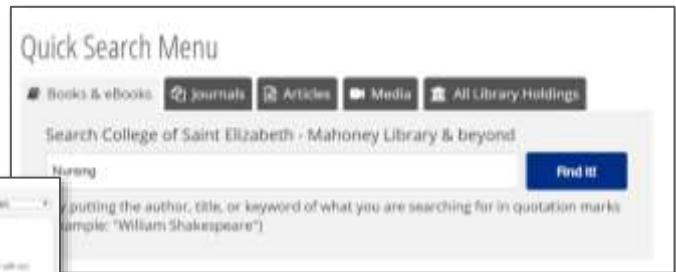
## III. Books.

- A. Reference collection: Crdo database of reference.
  - Over 900 online reference works (20 in education)
  - Links to database articles on similar topics
- B. Circulating collection.
  1. Over 100,000 books
  2. Over 200,000 ebooks.



## IV. The online catalog.

- A. lists both books and ebooks available.
  1. Either a link to the full text for ebooks, or a *Call Number* for print books will be provided.
- B. Search for journals, articles and media as well.



## V. Databases

A. **Education Research Complete:** Premier database for education with links to full text.

1. Search other databases such **ERIC** simultaneously.
2. Select the search you want to do (subject, keyword etc.) and click search.
  - a. Use asterisk (\*) as a wildcard for other letters (ie: teen\* = teens, teenage, etc.)
  - b. Use quotes ("" ) to search terms as a phrase (ie: "drug abuse")
  - c. Limit results to a specific data range, or to peer reviewed articles.

B. Other databases to try: **ProQuest Education Database** along with other ProQuest social science databases.

**Enter search terms**

**Scholarly (Peer Reviewed) Journals:** limits results to articles from peer reviewed publications.

**Publication Date** allowing you to limit results to a specific date range.

**Linked Full Text.** Limiting the results to records providing the contents of the record.

**Choose Databases:** Search multiple databases at once.

**Limit results to Full Text, Peer Review or by date.**

**Click title to open record**

**Access Full Text**

**Link Resolver to locate full text**

**Email, cite, Save, etc.**

**Abstract**

**Subject headings**

**B. Reviewing results**

1. Results appear below search screen.
2. Limit results further by date range, full text or scholarly peer review.
3. Click on the title of the article to open up the record (see below)

## VI. Searching for full text

A. If full text access is not provided in the database you are in, click on the **OCLC Link Resolver** link.

1. This should take you directly to the article.

B. If you are searching for full text access

to a specific article, click on the **Search Articles by Title** link below the Quick Search Menu on the library homepage.

1. On the next screen, enter the article title, the title of the publication, and click search.
2. If we have full text access to the article, it should appear directly from this search.
