Summary of Class of 2014 Employment Outcomes

The College of Saint Elizabeth follows the advice of the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) to collect post-graduation employment data six months after graduation. In February 2014, the College surveyed the 480 alumni from the Class of 2014.

Women's College 94 graduates under 26 years of age; 72% response rate

- 82% employed including 51 % having full-time employment with an average salary of \$35,000
- 25% attending graduate school (many combined part-time employment with graduate school)
- 12% unemployed by choice either because full-time graduate study or family responsibilities

Continuing Studies 146 adult undergraduates; 18% response rate

- 73% employed including 58% employed full-time with an average salary of \$40,500
- 33% were in graduate school (many combined part-time employment with graduate school)
- 19% unemployed by choice either because full-time graduate study or family responsibilities

<u>Graduate Programs</u> representing 240 post-baccalaureate certificates, masters and doctoral degree alumni; 32% response rate

- 87% employed virtually all full-time with an average salary of \$55,700
- 10% pursing further graduate study
- 7% unemployed by choice either because full-time graduate study or family responsibilities
